

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

OPEN SESSION MINUTES

Saturday, 10:00 am, at the Clubhouse March 18, 2017

1. The meeting was called to order at 10:02am.

2. <u>Roll Call-</u>, Bob Sutherland, Chris Qualls, Therese Harris, Rod Olguin, Randy Gillenwater were in attendance. Director Darryl Hall was absent

3. SUMMARY OF EXECUTIVE SESSION-

President Rod Olguin gave a brief summary of items discussed in Executive Session. Mark McMullen was announced as the New Board Director and is approved a signer for Oak Shores Community. Mark then took his seat as a Board Member.
