President's Message

As we come to the end of another year, I would first like to thank the outgoing Board Members for their hard work and commitment by serving on the board, Rod Olquin, Bob Sutherland, Chris Qualls and Therese Harris. Welcome to Board of Directors Kevin Libert , Mary Jo Del Campo, and Kent Douglas, Randy Feltman , Darryl Hall and Mark McMullen.

The 2017 year was very full of accomplishments, purchasing the west ramp, the back side of the pool landscaping and wall with the Oak Shores Sign. The purchase of a new public boat slip, that has 22 ten feet wide slips and 3' walkways. This replaced the old dock that had out-lived its useful life.

The 2018 budget was mailed out last week. The Finance Committee after much review and work, presented the Board with their recommendations. The Board, after the budget workshop and review, passed the budget at the November Board meeting.

We are scheduled to overlay the main road from the gate to the miniature golf course (2 ½ miles this fall, at a cost of approximately 800 thousand dollars. This is fully funded and is budgeted in the reserves for replacement.

This coming year we are in the process of purchasing the Maintenance Yard/Fire Station building. This is the first step in getting a seasonal fire crew to be staffed here in Oak Shores. The funds for the purchase are included in the 2018 budget and will be on the January Board agenda.

Thank you to our entire staff including, Gate Staff, Maintenance, and Management staff for the great job they did in 2017 and their continued hard work.

New Lakefront Sign for Oak Shores

Greetings to all!!

My name is John Watkins a 34 year resident of Oak Shores, I enjoyed being involved with concept development for many capital improvements within Oak Shores.

Recently, Steve Gasperson our manager, was envisioning a plan to improve the visual esthetics of our hillside below the pool. Steve's idea was to landscape that area, hide the pool equipment and install a sign. Having been involved in designing the front gate sign, Steve asked if I would develop a design and plans for construction of the sign.

Mark McMullen, a resident retired landscape contractor, would be developing plans for the landscaping and irrigation.

The new Oak Shores sign is placed just below the pool structure. A stucco backdrop was built to match the existing retaining walls below the patio. The letters were cut from corten steel and suspended in front of the backdrop. The sign measures about 20 feet long and about 5 feet high, lighted and large enough to be read from the lake to greet all entering into our marina day or night.

Mark McMullen who also chose the plantings at the front gate utilized largely the same varieties that proved successful in that area to be used in this hillside project.

Our own Maintenance crew was instrumental in the installation of the sign, the plantings, irrigation, relocation of the Lake pass iron maiden as well as the supporting infrastructure.

The cost of the project came to almost \$15,000.00. This community improvement was paid for by fund raising by Recreation Committee and Logos, one half by Logos and one half by the Recreation Committee.

At this writing I believe that Oak Shores is the only lakeside community to display a sign to identify the community from the lake. So as you pull into our marina you will know **"You Have Arrived"** at the best Nacimiento lakeside community.

In closing I wish to acknowledge all of those who made our latest project possible.

- Our Manager, Steve Gasperson, for his inspiration and overseeing the progress.
- Our Maintenance Staff, their quality efforts and hard labor and installation to make it all possible.
- Recreation Committee, for sharing their funds generated by Oak Shores events.

**NEWS FROM THE NACIMIENTO REGIONAL WATER
MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE ("NRWMAC")
Bng Smith, Director NRWAC**

An email was received on October 31, by Don Bullard, President of NRWAC, from David Chardayoyne, General Manager of the Monterey County Water Resources Board (MCWRA). (MCWRA is the agency involved in building the Interlake Tunnel.) The following is excerpted from that email:

"At the moment, there is a significant delay in resolution of the white bass issue with CDFW (California Department of Fish and Wildlife). Resolution of that issue is key to moving forward with the Tunnel Project."

What is significant about this statement is that the issue of the white bass, a predatory fish that inhabits only Lake Nacimiento, has forced MCWRA back to square one. They are being told by CDFW that they must have a fish screen in the tunnel inlet in Lake Nacimiento that is no larger than 0.5mm to prevent white bass from entering Lake San Antonio. MCWRA has been trying to convince CDFW to allow white bass into San Antonio. Failing that, they will resort to pursuing a legislative solution.

Phil Humphrey, a Director on the NRWAC Board, was interviewed on October 30th, by Dave Congalton, of KVEC radio. Phil spoke about the proposed Interlake Tunnel Project and the threat to Lake Nacimiento of invasive mussels, among other things. Here is a link to the podcast:

AT&T Cell Phone Problems Diane Taylor

AT&T cell service within Oak Shores has degraded over the last three weeks. Problems being experienced include;

- * dropped calls
- * not being able to call at all
- * one bar of available service
- * can't send texts, receive error message
- * texts never being received or extreme delays

I spoke with a very knowledgeable AT&T customer support representative. He said it's possible that another cell phone service provider was utilizing our AT&T tower and has fallen out of contract with AT&T. Meaning the excellent service we were getting was not necessarily from AT&T but from another service provider. This happens all the time. They may or may not resign with AT&T and there's no way of knowing which service provider it is/was.

He recommended users experiencing these problems to install a FREE app called; AT&T Mark the Spot. When they encounter a problem using their cell phone they need to run the application and identify what problem they encountered and it will automatically send GPS coordinates to AT&T Network support representatives. Getting multiple feedback from multiple users might help them identify the problem.

It's super easy and quick to install and use. Please help me report these problems to work towards a resolution other than switching cell phone providers which is not a good option.
