- 1. The meeting was called to order via Zoom at 10:16 am.
- 2. Rod Olguin, Mary Jo Del Campo, Randy Feltman, Kevin Libert, Darryl Hall, Michele Lauffer and General Manager Stephanie Dayton were in attendance via Zoom.

3. SUMMARY OF EXECUTIVE SESSION
