# WELCOME TO OAK SHORES

### **GUEST and RENTERS**

GUEST: Please keep your ORANGE GUEST pass visible on your dashboard at all times.

RENTERS: Make sure that your <u>RED RENTER PASS</u> is attached to your rearview mirror at all times.

RENTERS: Only 2 vehicles are allowed at the rental house and those vehicles must be the ones displaying the RED RENTER PASS. (NO switching the passes to another vehicle). It is a \$100.00 fine if you park anywhere other than overflow after that 1 hour.

### WATERCRAFT

ONLY 1 GUEST/RENTER WATERCRAFT TRAILER IS ALLOWED PER PROPERTY
AT ANY TIME

A \$5.00 Mussel Inspection Fee will be charged at the Gate to Renters and Guests

- a) All Renters and Guests bringing a watercraft into Oak Shores must pay a \$25 watercraft fee per day watercraft is in the Oak Shores Community. If you rent a boat at Nacimiento Resort or from a private party and plan to use Oak Shores slips, you must pay Oak Shores fees of \$25 per day at the gate when you enter.
- b) Each watercraft entering Nacimiento Lake is required to pay a fee to Monterey County Parks Dept. Payment Stations are located at the front gate area and the launch ramps. You can also pay online at www.golakenaci.com
- c) Between Memorial and Labor Day, homeowners, guests and renters watercrafts may be parked in the public slips. Watercraft can only be in the slips for 7 days then you must take your watercraft out for 3 days.
- d) Public slips are first come first serve and may not be reserved or roped off.
- e) The Main Marina and West Ramps are closed between 10pm and 6am.
- f) Inside the Oak Shores Log Boom is a wake-less zone, skiing startups and drop-offs are not permitted and no towable or water toys.



Note: All watercraft are subject to a Mussel Inspection before launching. Without a Stamped Permit on the Lake there can be a \$2000 fine issued by Rangers or SLO Sheriffs

NOTE: Upon leaving
Oak Shores, all watercraft and camping permits, rentals and 1 hour
passes must be returned to the gate staff
or deposited in the designated box on the side
of the gatehouse.



## QUIET TIMES Between 10pm-7am

Strictly Enforced

Quiet time is between 10 pm and 7 am. Any person (s) making excessive noise between those hours may receive a warning for the first offense. If the noise continues, a fine of \$200 will be issued. If within 24-hour period the noise continues, the fine will double. All fines are doubled during Holiday weekends.

9 am—10 pm April - October
(Weather Permitting)
Pool is Closed October to April

You will need a Gate Card to access the pool.


NO GLASS containers inside the gated pool area.



- At next stop sign turn right onto Interlake Road (G-14) and continue 6.6 mile
- Next stop sign turn right onto Nacimiento Lake Drive (G-14) and continue 9.3 miles
- Next stop sign turn left to continue on Nacimiento Lake Drive (G-14)
- Continue **traveling straight into Paso Robles** until you reach the intersection to Hwy 101 South and enter onto "US—101 South"
- Continue on Hwy 101 South for 6.0 miles then **exit onto Las Tablas Road turn right** at stop light. Continue straight Hospital will be on the right.

### **NEED GROCERIES, ICE OR GAS**


Oak Hills Market has it all located off Interlake Road past the Nacimiento Dam on

### **FISHING**

- 1. The Main Marina and West Ramps are closed between 10pm-6am.
- 2. Fishing from the Association docks <u>will be</u> allowed as long as it does not interfere with the watercraft traffic.
- 3. Fishing <u>will not</u> be allowed from the public docks if it poses a hazard to anyone else that is attempting to use docks.
- 4. A person fishing from the docks <u>will not</u> be allowed to block any portion of the walkway.
- 5. Any person fishing from the docks may have <u>only one (1)</u> pole in the water at anytime.
- 6. Any person fishing from the docks <u>must be responsible</u> for removing any and all fishing materials upon departing.
- 7. <u>No cleaning of fish</u> on the docks at anytime or at the Clubhouse sink area.
